

## *Dear Colleagues,*

You are invited to submit your abstracts and full papers to the 3<sup>rd</sup> International Congress Complex Systems in Medicine and Sport (ICCSMS2010).

The Congress will take place in Kaunas, Lithuania, on 15 – 18 September 2010 at the Europa Royale Kaunas hotel conference centre. It is organized by Kaunas University of Medicine (KMU), Kaunas University of Technology (KTU) and Lithuanian Academy of Physical Education (LKKA).

## *Aims and Objectives*

This joint Congress is intended to combine the recent major contributions of internationally recognised scientists working in different aspects of Complex Systems in Medicine and Sport. The main aim is to serve as a forum for the multidisciplinary exchange of ideas between professionals for the development of theory, practice and research in different fields of Medicine and Sport. Scientists from both areas have started to apply tools and concepts of Non-linear Dynamics, Dynamical Systems Theory, Chaos Theory, Thermodynamics, etc. This congress aims to encourage this attempt by gathering them in Kaunas, in September.

Authors of accepted abstracts, Keynotes and Speakers are invited to submit full papers (by special form, placed at Congress website <http://conference.ktu.lt/iccsms2010/documents> ) that will be peer reviewed and together with abstracts published in the Congress CD.
